2019 INTERNATIONAL TRAVELING FELLOW PROGRAM

<u>Purpose</u>: The American Society for Surgery of the Hand invites official IFSSH recognized Hand Societies to nominate a Traveling Fellow to visit hand surgery centers within the United States and to attend the annual meeting of the ASSH.

<u>Process</u>: The visiting fellow should be selected by a participating country's Hand Society and must meet the following criteria: **fellows must be under 45 years of age and must not have participated in this program in the past.** We will waive the qualifying fellow's registration fee for attendance at the ASSH Annual Meeting and the Traveling Fellow will have the opportunity to visit hand surgery centers in the U.S. prior to and after the ASSH Annual Meeting. All travel, housing and meal costs will be the responsibility of the Traveling Fellow or his/her sponsoring country's Hand Society. This award is limited to **one participant** per hand society per calendar year.

The fellows will travel together in pre-determined groups.
